Weather permitting, the pool will be open from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM every day except Monday, when it will be closed for maintenance. If Monday is a holiday, the pool will remain open and close on Tuesday.

- The Olde Towne pool is not an Olympic-size pool, nor is it large enough for doing laps. It is however, a small community-gathering place for our residents to relax, suntan or cool off.
- It is considered a public bathing place and as such is controlled by the County Health Department. The Rules & Regulations are set forth by the Health Dept. and violations will result in pool closure.
- Due to insurance regulations, parties are not permissible.
- All residents of Olde Towne, in good standing, are eligible for pool usage.
- According to our insurance experts, the owners collectively, can be held responsible for any accidents occurring on the Olde Towne property. For that reason, the Association requires that the pool member resident must be present, (extenuating circumstances aside) whenever the guests are using the pool.
