- The Olde Towne pool is not an Olympic-size pool, nor is it large enough for doing laps. It is however, a small community-gathering place for our residents to relax, suntan or cool off.
- It is considered a public bathing place and as such is controlled by the County Health Department. The Rules & Regulations are set forth by the Health Dept. and violations will result in pool closure.
- Due to insurance regulations, parties are not permissible.
- All residents of Olde Towne, in good standing, are eligible for pool usage.
- According to our insurance experts, the owners collectively, can be held responsible for any
  accidents occurring on the Olde Towne property. For that reason, the Association requires that
  the <u>pool member resident must be present</u>, (extenuating circumstances aside) whenever the
  guests are using the pool.
